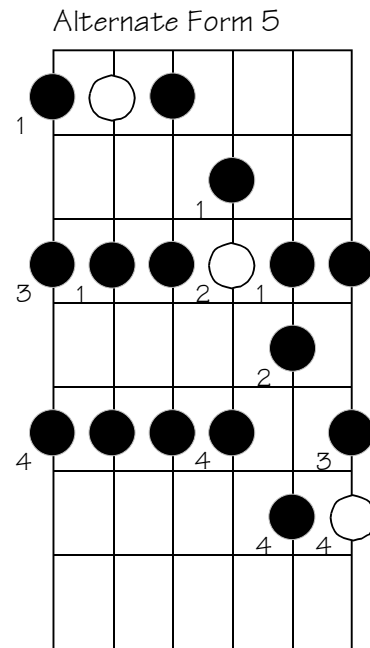
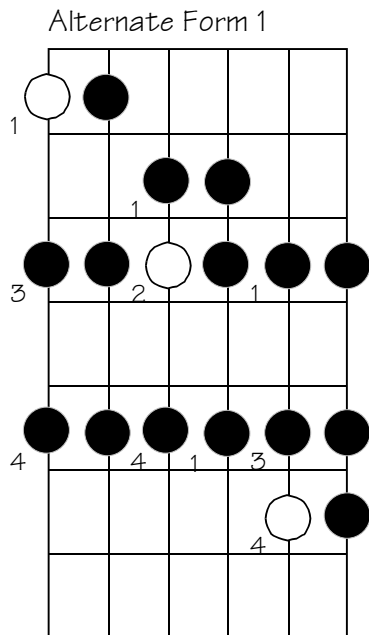


Alternate Major Scale Forms

These alternate forms are useful reading forms, alternative to the popular position reading forms 1 and 2. Extending the number of notes per string to 3 provides a greater range, smoother tone variations, and provides more of the mobility that is required by most music.



These forms all have 3 notes per string. There are other 3-note-per-string forms; however, these are particularly convenient because of their consistent, visual organization of scale roots.
